There are also two types of special connections:


**Include** (B  $\rightarrow$  A) - this connection shows that use case B is **dependent** on A, and usually use case B cannot happen before use case A. For example:

#### ENTER THE ROOM → INCLUDE → OPEN THE DOOR

**Extend** (B  $\rightarrow$  A) - this connection shows that use case B is a **part** of A, and very often use case B is more specific than use case A. For example:

#### EAT AN APPLE → EXTEND → EAT A FRUIT

- Create Account allow a new user to register account;
- Log in to Account allow user to enter into their account;
- > Log out from Account allow user to exit from their account;
- > Input Search Query allow user to look for articles on web;
- > View Article from the Search Results allow user to view found articles;
- View Article from the Main Page allow user to access some articles directly from the main page;
- Leave a Comment allow a user to write and submit a comment for an article;
- Leave a Rating (Like/Dislike) allow a user to leave a feedback on an article;

# **Development Tools Analysis**

It is also crucial to define software tools that will be used during development and management of the website. The in advace defined workflow tools significantly increase efficiency and productivity of work and maintain consistency of the project.

The following set of tools will be the foundation of the project:

- WordPress a free open-source content management system (CMS) that allows to creating and managing websites.
- Visual Studio Code (VS Code) a integrated development environment (IDE) developed by Microsoft. It is used to develop computer programs including websites.
- XAMPP a free and open-source cross-platform web server solution stack package.
  XAMPP stands for "Cross-platform," "Apache," "MySQL," "PHP," and "Perl."
- > Paletton an online color scheme designer tool that is used for creating color palettes for web design.
- GitHub a web-based version control platform used for software projects.

# **Website Templates Analysis**

The type of my website is **educational**, therefore it shouldn't have graficaly sophisticated theme, but rather have a clean and intuitive design, that will allow users to find the needed information **quickly** and **easily**.

Those types of educational web resources are usually called 'wikis' (short form of Wikipedia). Thus, I decided to browse the WordPress themes by using the keyword 'wiki' in the search query. Fortunately, I have found and collected information about several free WordPress 'wiki' themes. Then I have defined several criterias for selecting a more suitable theme:

- \* Rating of the theme should be 4.5 or above;
- Number of active installs should be above 500 (wiki themes aren't very popular);
- ❖ Date last update should not be before year 2023;

If condition is satisfied theme gets plus (+) mark, else theme recieves minus (-) mark. Therefore, the theme that scores the most pluses will be the most suitable for my website.


